## **Note Verbale dated 6 May 2025 from the Permanent Mission of the Russian Federation to the United Nations Office and other International Organizations in Geneva, addressed to the Secretary General of the Conference on Disarmament, transmitting a communication on the documentary film by Russia Today entitled "Toxic War"\***

The Permanent Mission of the Russian Federation to the United Nations Office and other International Organizations in Geneva presents its compliments to the Secretariat of the Conference on Disarmament (CD) and has the honour to inform it of the following.

The Russian Federation continues to collect and analyse the information about blatant violations by Ukraine of its obligations under international law, including those under the Chemical Weapons Convention (CWC), and to convey the verified data thereon to the Organisation for the Prohibition of Chemical Weapons, the United Nations and the whole international community.

In this regard the Russian Side would like to draw the attention of the CD Secretariat to the fact that on 3 April 2025 the premiere screening of the documentary film by RT entitled "Toxic War" took place. The documentary demonstrates the evidence of the Kiev regime's systematic and massive use of toxic substances, riot control agents or warfare chemical agents against the Russian military and civilians in the area of the special military operation, which constitutes a gross violation of Article I of the CWC by Ukraine.
