Proposed amendments to the draft Declaration

A. Review and appraisal

Paragraph 1:

Delete the first sentence in brackets.

Paragraph 8:

(a) The first sentence should read as follows:

"Removing the threat of a world war is a most acute and urgent task of the present day."

(b) Delete the second sentence in brackets.

B. Goals and priorities

Paragraph 2:

The second sentence should read as follows:

"To this end it is equally imperative to remove the threat of nuclear weapons, to halt and reverse the nuclear arms race by stopping the production of nuclear weapons and ...".

C. Principles

Paragraph 7:

The first sentence should read as follows:

"The use or threat of use of force including nuclear weapons against the sovereignty and territorial integrity of any State is indefensible."

Paragraph 8:

Line 6 should read as follows:

"The nuclear-weapon States should undertake legally binding ...".

Paragraph 9:

The first sentence should read as follows:

"Disarmament, relaxation of international tension, respect for the right to self-determination and national independence and the strengthening ...".

Paragraph 14:

In line 5, the word "ultimately" should be deleted.
