Working paper submitted by Mauritius

It is proposed that the following should be inserted in the draft final document of the special session of the General Assembly (A/S-10/1 - vol. 1):

- (1) Insert on page 22, paragraph 3 as fourth sentence:

"The procedures of the negotiating bodies should enable that all views, interests and proposals be duly considered and taken into account."

- (2) Insert on page 47 a new point (i) (d) and renumber the other two points accordingly:

"Consensus should mean a process of intensive and extensive real consultations and negotiations with the participation of States and duly taking into account all their views and interests so that the agreements reached could enjoy the largest support without serious opposition or substantive reservations."

- (3) Add to point (v) on page 48 the sentence:

"These rules should enable that all views, interests and proposals of States be duly considered and taken into account."

- (4) Add a new paragraph at the end of the draft text on machinery:

"The Secretary-General should be invited to attend or designate his representatives to attend disarmament conferences and negotiations taking place outside the framework of the United Nations and to report on them, as appropriate, to the General Assembly."
