

Dear Sir,

We, the undersigned, in order that we may avoid the total destruction of humankind and create a peaceful world without nuclear weapons or war, strongly urge, through this special session on disarmament, the actualization of the following:-

1. To call all nations to an understanding of the horror of a nuclear holocaust through the actual experience of Hiroshima, Nagasaki, and nuclear experiments, and to enact a total ban on nuclear weapons.
2. To formulate an international agreement which will promptly and completely ban all development of and experiments with nuclear weapons, as well as the production, storing, deployment and the usage of such weapons ON THE BASIS THAT THE USE OF NUCLEAR WEAPONS IS A SERIOUS CRIMINAL ACT AGAINST ALL HUMANKIND.
3. To promptly establish an international disarmament agreement.
