The Office for Disarmament Affairs presents its compliments to the Permanent Missions of Member States to the United Nations and has the honour to refer to resolution [79/16](#) “Establishment of a nuclear-weapon-free zone in the region of the Middle East” adopted by the General Assembly on 2 December 2024.

By operative paragraphs 10 and 11 of the resolution, the General Assembly:

“Requests the Secretary-General to continue to pursue consultations with the States of the region and other concerned States, in accordance with paragraph 7 of resolution 46/30 and taking into account the evolving situation in the region, and to seek from those States their views on the measures outlined in chapters III and IV of the study annexed to the report of the Secretary-General of 10 October 1990¹ or other relevant measures, in order to move towards the establishment of a nuclear-weapon-free zone in the region of the Middle East;”

“Also requests the Secretary-General to submit to the General Assembly at its eightieth session a report on the implementation of the present resolution;”

The Office for Disarmament Affairs would like to refer to resolutions [52/214](#) and [53/208](#) entitled “Pattern of Conferences”, adopted by the General Assembly on 22 December 1997 and 18 December 1998 respectively.

Pursuant to the above-mentioned resolutions, all intergovernmental bodies are kindly requested to restrict the length of their submissions without adversely affecting either the quality of presentation or their content. **Depending on the total number of views received, executive summaries may be requested for inclusion in the report, while views in full would be published on the UNODA Website.** The word limit for this report issued by the Secretariat, including all submissions provided by Member States, is **10,700 words**.

In order to facilitate the submission of the views on the issues outlined above by Member States, the deadline for submission is **30 May 2025**.

As the previous year, Member States are invited to submit their views through e-DeleGATE (General Assembly>First Committee>e-Submit). Only MS Word Version files will be accepted. Any substantive question related to this report may be directed to Tomisha Bino (tomisha.bino@un.org).
