Report:

In 2024 the Czech Republic implemented all commitments stemming from international agreements on arms control, disarmament and confidence- and security-building measures. The verification activities were affected by the conflict in Ukraine.

The Czech Republic according to the **Vienna Document:**

- conducted two inspections of specified area and one evaluation visit abroad;
- participated in four inspections of specified area and in one training inspection of specified area abroad;
- participated in four training evaluation visits abroad;
- conducted one training evaluation visit abroad;
- received one international training evaluation visit on the territory of the Czech Republic;
- participated in four visits to air base;
- participated in five visits to other military facilities;
- participated in two demonstrations of new types of weapons;
- participated in two observations of certain military activities.

The Czech Republic according to the **Treaty on Open Skies:**

- participated in two multinational observation flights;
- participated in one multinational training observation flight.

The Czech Republic according to the **Dayton Peace Agreement:**

- participated as a guest OSCE observer in one inspection (Article IV).

The Czech Republic according to the **Chemical Weapons Convention** (Convention on the Prohibition of the Development, Production, Stockpiling and Use of Chemical Weapons and on their Destruction):

- received one international inspection on the territory of the Czech Republic.

In connection with the Czech Republic suspension of the **Treaty on Conventional Armed Forces in Europe** only training verification activities were held:
