The Office for Disarmament Affairs presents its compliments to the Permanent Missions of Member States to the United Nations and has the honour to refer to resolution [79/32](#) “Follow-up to the advisory opinion of the International Court of Justice on the legality of the threat or use of nuclear weapons” adopted by the General Assembly on 2 December 2024.

By operative paragraph 3 of the resolution, the General Assembly:

*“Requests all States to inform the Secretary-General of the efforts and measures which they have taken with respect to the implementation of the present resolution and nuclear disarmament, and requests the Secretary-General to apprise the General Assembly of that information at its eightieth session;”*

The Office for Disarmament Affairs would like to refer to resolutions [52/214](#) and [53/208](#) entitled “Pattern of Conferences”, adopted by the General Assembly on 22 December 1997 and 18 December 1998 respectively.

Pursuant to the above-mentioned resolutions, all intergovernmental bodies are kindly requested to restrict the length of their submissions without adversely affecting either the quality of presentation or their content. **Depending on the total number of views received, executive summaries may be requested for inclusion in the report, while views in full would be published on the UNODA Website.** The word limit for this report issued by the Secretariat, including all submissions provided by Member States, is **10,700 words**.

In order to facilitate the submission of the views on the issues outlined above by Member States, the deadline for submission is **30 May 2025**.

**As the previous year, Member States are invited to submit their views through e-DeleGATE (General Assembly>First Committee>e-Submit).** Only MS Word Version files will be accepted. **Any views received after 30 May 2025 will be posted on the website of the Office for Disarmament Affairs in the original language received. No addenda will be issued.**
