

Disarmament and non-proliferation education

Office for Outer Space Affairs

The Office for Outer Space Affairs is responsible for advancing international cooperation in space activities. While its primary mandate is not directly related to disarmament and non-proliferation, the Office plays an important role in strengthening international cooperation and developing frameworks for the exploration and use of outer space exclusively for peaceful purposes, which indirectly supports the broader goals of disarmament and non-proliferation education.

During the reporting period, the Office supported and contributed to the efforts of the Office for Disarmament Affairs and other entities engaged in disarmament and non-proliferation to increase awareness and facilitate dialogue among States and other relevant stakeholders, including the following: i) 2025 United Nations Programme of Fellowships on Disarmament; ii) Outer Space Security Conference, held by the United Nations Institute for Disarmament Research; iii) ASEAN Regional Forum Workshop on Peace and Security in Outer Space; iv) the twenty-fourth United Nations – Republic of Korea Joint Conference on Disarmament and Non-Proliferation Issues.
