Report:

In 2025 the Czech Republic implemented all commitments stemming from international agreements on arms control, disarmament and confidence- and security-building measures. The verification activities were affected by the conflict in Ukraine.

The Czech Republic according to the **Vienna Document:**

- organized and conducted two inspections of specified area and one evaluation visit abroad;
- participated in three inspections of specified area;
- participated in two evaluation visits;
- participated in two training evaluation visits abroad;
- received one training inspection of specified area on the territory of the Czech Republic;
- organized and conducted visit to air base on the territory of the Czech Republic;
- organized and conducted visit to military facility on the territory of the Czech Republic;
- organized and conducted demonstration of new types of major weapon and equipment systems on the territory of the Czech Republic;
- participated in twelve visits to air base;
- participated in twelve visits to other military facilities;
- participated in five demonstrations of new types of major weapon and equipment systems;
- participated in one observation of certain military activities.

The Czech Republic according to the **Treaty on Open Skies:**

- conducted two multinational observation flights;
- conducted two multinational training observation flights.

The Czech Republic according to the **Dayton Peace Agreement:**

- participated as a guest OSCE observer in one Article IV inspection.

The Czech Republic according to the **Chemical Weapons Convention** (Convention on the Prohibition of the Development, Production, Stockpiling and Use of Chemical Weapons and on their Destruction):

- did not receive any international inspection on the territory of the Czech Republic.

The Czech Republic suspended the **Treaty on Conventional Armed Forces in Europe** in 2023 and since that time only training verification activities have been carried out. In 2025 the Czech Republic:

- participated in two training inspections abroad;
- received one international training inspection on the territory of the Czech Republic.
