Turkish Space Agency's reviews on transparency and confidence-building measures in outer space activities are summarised and presented below:

- In order to sustain the peaceful use of outer space, working in collaboration and good faith would be important.
- The importance of the Outer Space Treaty is emphasized. The outer space is not subject to national appropriation or solely pursuing national interests, and activities in outer space must be for the benefit and welfare of all countries.
- Registering space objects according to The Registration Convention of 1975, as states that states should register their space objects with the United Nations, is important to increase transparency in outer space.
- Rendezvous and proximity operations should not be done to other states' space objects without their consent.
- Space policies should be published by states to increase transparency in outer space activities.
- States should share contact lists for emergencies among their related authorities to increase the transparency and confidence in outer space activities and they should establish direct communication channels to prevent misunderstandings.
- Exchange of information, transparency and situational awareness among States should be encouraged.
